(i) Part I: Part I is confined to Mental Ability Test (MAT) consisting of 90 compulsory questions.

9 am to 11 am	Disabled candidates only

(ii) Part II: Part II is confined to Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) consisting of 90 compulsory questions from Social Science, General Science and Mathematics.

11.30 am to 01.00 pm	All candidates except disabled candidates
11.30 am to 01.30 pm	Disabled candidates only

7. Time for Part I is 90 minutes and for Part II is 90 minutes.
8. Each question carries 1 (one) mark.
9. Write your Roll Number, as given in the Admission Card on the Answer Sheet and on the cover page of the Question Booklet in the space provided.
10. DO NOT write your name in any part of the Question Booklet or the **Answer Sheet**.
11. All questions in the booklets are objective type. For each questions FOUR possible answers are given but only one is correct. Your task is to find out the correct answer and mark your choice in the Answer Sheet.
12. During the Examination follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
13. Hand over your question booklet and Answer sheet to the invigilator before you leave the Examination Hall.

- (2) Do not send the identification certificate along with your application form.
- (3) Use only blue or black point pen.
- (4) Cross (X) only one of the appropriate boxes in item nos. 4,5,6,7 and 10
- (5) Eligibility for appearing for State Level NTSE and NMMSE 2011-12
  - (a) Only those pupils who are studying in class VIII of any government/ aided/ recognized schools/ Kendriya Vidyalaya/ Navodaya Vidyalaya during 2011 -2012 are eligible to appear for the State Level NTSE.
  - (b) Only those pupils who are studying in Class VIII of any government or aided schools following the state syllabus are eligible for appear for the NMMSE.
  - (c) For the State Level NTSE and NMMSE, only those pupils who have secured not less than C+ grade (51% - 55%) for all the non-language subjects in the qualifying examination of Class VII of 2010-'11 will be admitted. This is to be certified by the Head of Institution.
  - (d) Only those pupils whose parental annual income is not above Rs.1,50,000 (Rupees one lakh fifty thousand only) are eligible to appear for the NMMSE. Original income certificate from a competent authority should be attached along with the application for NMMSE.
- (6) The application should be accompanied by
  - (a) The application form includes first four pages
  - (b) Two photographs - one on the application form and the other on the Admission Card both duly attested.
  - (c) The original DD for Rs.100 (Rs.200 if the candidate applies for both the examinations) in favour of the Director SCERT drawn on or before 15 September 2011 payable at SBT Service Branch, Thiruvananthapuram. (SC/ST/BPL categories are exempted from fees)
